ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation (Deemed to be University) traces its origin to 1981, with the establishment of the Thirumuruga Kirupananda Variyar Thavathiru Sundara Swamigal Medical Educational and Charitable Trust (TKVTSSMECT). Building on this foundation, the visionary Founder-Chairman, Dr. A. Shanmugasundaram, established the Vinayaka Mission's College of Pharmacy, Salem, in 1982—a pioneering step that marked the beginning of Vinayaka Missions' journey in the field of education.

A landmark moment came in 2001, when Vinayaka Missions was conferred the prestigious status of a "Deemed to be University" by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, with the recommendation of the University Grants Commission (UGC) under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956. This recognition was a testament to the institution's unwavering commitment to academic excellence, adherence to the highest educational standards, and creation of world-class infrastructure. With this milestone, Vinayaka Missions was transformed into Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation (VMRF), becoming the 48th Deemed to be University in India.

Today, VMRF (Deemed to be University) encompasses an expansive academic ecosystem with 13 Colleges and 13 Schools, including: Medical, Engineering, Dental, Pharmacy, Homoeopathy, Physiotherapy, Nursing, Arts & Science, Allied Health Sciences, Law, Physical Education, Rehabilitation and Behavioral Sciences, Health Systems, Economics, and Public Policy. These institutions are strategically spread across Salem and Chennai campus in Tamil Nadu, as well as Puducherry and Karaikal in the Union Territory of Puducherry.
